

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Southern England and much of Wales will have rain today, and it will be heavy and persistent in places later. Further north there will be sunshine, but also blustery showers in the northwest. Rain in England and Wales will clear in the evening to leave a mostly dry and frost free night with clear spells.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Sunday will be largely dry, albeit fresher, with some sunshine. However, patchy rain will affect northwest England, and the north and west of Scotland. Winds will ease in the north. Monday will be cloudy with outbreaks of rain spreading eastwards across the British Isles.
