Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Rain in the far southeast will clear by early afternoon. Otherwise, many places will have a dry and bright Remembrance Sunday. However, there will be some showers, these mainly across coastal areas in the southwest where they will be heavy.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

A largely bright morning for many on Monday, but with heavy showers across southern coastal counties. However, wet and windy conditions in the west will push east through the day. By Tuesday, the rain will become slow-moving across eastern England and eastern Scotland. Elsewhere, Tuesday will be a day of sunny intervals and showers, some of which will be heavy.
