

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 1945 on Friday 10 Jul 2015

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
After a largely dry start with scattered showers across northwestern areas, more persistent rain will spread westwards through the day, affecting Ireland and Western Scotland by the afternoon. Elsewhere, it will be largely dry with the best of the sunshine through the morning but with thickening cloud from the west by afternoon and with fresher temperatures than of late.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Rain will clear most southern areas through Sunday morning with sunny spells and scattered showers following from the north. After a dry start, it will turn wet across much of England and Wales through Monday but with drier conditions further north.
