Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
A very cold and icy start with temperatures struggling to rise above zero through the day in many areas. Snow showers continuing in many eastern and southeastern areas, spreading to some central areas at times. Otherwise a good deal of sunshine, especially in western parts. Freshening winds across southeastern areas making it feel bitterly cold.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:
Dry and bright for many on Saturday, although further snow showers expected, especially in the east. On Sunday, more persistent snow will spread across southern parts of the UK but it should remain drier and brighter in the north. Bitterly cold easterly winds.
