Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :

Mainly cloudy, with patchy light rain or drizzle at times where exposed to the north and west. Sunny intervals for some eastern and southern areas. Mild, but breezy over some coasts and hills. Further patchy rain or drizzle at times in the northwest and also parts of the east coast. Elsewhere mainly cloudy but some mist and ground frost where clear skies persist.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Thursday most parts dry, but patchy drizzle exposed areas with more general rain into northwest Scotland later. Staying mild. On Friday, outbreaks of rain across the north, heavy on western hills, but mainly dry in the south.
