Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Scotland, Northern Ireland increasingly cloudy, rain spreading from northwest from late morning. The far north becoming windy. Rain clearing overnight, then showers in western Scotland, prolonged in far north. England, Wales dry with good sunny spells, north becoming cloudy in afternoon, then rain moving south and becoming patchy, reaching southern England, East Anglia by dawn.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:
Wednesday, strong winds and showers, sometimes prolonged, north and west Scotland. Showers spreading across Northern Ireland, reaching northwest England. Dry, sunny spells elsewhere. Thursday, rain or showers and strong winds across Scotland. Freshening winds elsewhere, showers in west, brighter in east. Feeling cooler.
