Headline:

Remaining very unsettled with showers or longer spells of rain.

Today:

Rain across northern Scotland clearing northwards. Elsewhere, sunshine and showers, some becoming heavy with thunder, downpours bringing localised flooding. Some longer spells of rain possible in the south where it will be rather windy.

Tonight:

Showers dying back to southern and some western coasts. Most places becoming dry.

Outlook for Wednesday:

Sunshine and heavy, blustery showers, locally thundery. Feeling cool in rather strong winds.
