

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Friday 02 Nov 2012

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:

A breezy, rather cold day of sunny spells and showers, some showers heavy with hail or thunder and locally wintry on hills. Western areas and the south coast probably seeing the most frequent showers, but they shouldn't be ruled out elsewhere. Little change overnight, but temperatures falling low enough for patchy frost in many areas.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Continuing unsettled, often breezy and rather cold. Showers or sometimes longer spells of rain are likely for many areas, with Saturday particularly seeing them turn wintry on high ground. Dry and sunny periods too however, especially in eastern parts of the UK.
