Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Cloud and rain will gradually clear the southeast to give a mainly fine day
countrywide with some good sunny spells. Parts of the north may see a few
showers however, while the far south of England may stay rather cloudy. Cold,
dry and clear overnight, with localised fog patches developing and with rural
frost in central and northern areas.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Dry and fine for most on Sunday, with isolated showers in the far north.
Becoming increasingly cloudy in the southwest during the afternoon, with rain
later. Remaining fine in the north on Monday, cloudier in the south with some
rain.
