Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Patchy mist and fog at first, with showery rain in places this morning, but most areas will become dry and bright for a time. More widespread rain will reach Northern Ireland, western Scotland and southwest England later, spreading across most parts tonight, before clearer skies follow from the northwest.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Some rain during Thursday morning in southeast England, with showers over northern Scotland. Elsewhere, the day will be dry with sunny spells. Feeling colder in the windier north. On Friday most areas will be dry with sunny spells. However, showers are likely in the northeast with rain in western Scotland later.
