Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Sunday will be a fresher-feeling day, with a southerly breeze felt across the country. The remainder of overnight rain will ease and gradually clear from northeastern UK to be replaced by sunshine and scattered showers from the southwest. Some of these showers may turn heavy at times, with a risk of thunder.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Becoming cooler into the new working week, with the winds turning southwesterly as the theme of sunshine and showers continues across the country. The best of the dry weather is likely in the south and east, where temperatures will be a little above normal for mid-spring.
