Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Much of the UK will enjoy a dry day with sunny spells and only isolated showers, although showers will be more frequent across Western Scotland. It will be breezy across Scotland but winds will be light elsewhere making it feel warm. Partly clear skies overnight will lead to a cool night with showers continuing across Western Scotland.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Most areas will stay fine and warm on Tuesday with light winds and further sunny spells although rain will affect Northern Ireland and Western Scotland later. It will become largely cloudy on Wednesday with patchy rain but staying dry across southeastern areas.
