Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Friday:-Many places dry with some bright/sunny spells developing, the best of these in the south/east. Staying rather cloudy near some western coasts, with patchy drizzle in places. Temperatures, near normal in north, locally warm in sunnier parts of south.
Friday evening/night: Rather cloudy across the northwest with rain/drizzle, also cloudy down some western coasts of England and Wales, where mist/ hill fog patches are expected. Clear spells inland.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

A good deal of dry weather, with good sunny spells developing across many places. Still rather cloudy at times near western coasts, and also across the northwest. Very warm in sunnier spots
