Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Most of the UK will be cloudy and quite breezy with outbreaks of rain or drizzle. Some of the rain in the hills of Western Scotland and Cumbria could be heavy. Southern parts of England are likely to see the best of any brighter weather. Staying cloud and mild overnight with further rain or drizzle.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:
Staying unsettled and breezy with further spells of rain. Some of the rain could be heavy at times over the high ground in Western Scotland. For southern parts of England and South Wales it should be drier, brighter and warmer during the afternoon and evening.
