Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Most places will have a cloudy morning as a band of rain moves southeastwards across the UK. Sunny spells will developed in central and northern England and eastern Scotland, but it will stay cloudy and damp elsewhere. Winds will strengthen across the UK overnight with gales and increasingly wintry showers in Scotland, whilst other areas become largely dry.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Very windy, especially on Monday when severe gales will affect parts of the northwestern of the UK. Wintry showers will affect mainly northern areas on Monday, but will become much more widespread across all areas by Tuesday. It will feel cold.
