
Daily Air Quality Index – Friday 24/06/2022




Daily Air Quality Index – Saturday 25/06/2022

Air Quality Forecast for the UK

Issued by the Met Office

Today: Light winds and ongoing warm weather across England and Wales will lead to the buildup of widespread Moderate air pollution levels, although Low levels are expected across the southeast with cooler and cloudier weather compared to recent days. Generally Low levels are also expected across Northern Ireland and Scotland.

Tomorrow: Moderate air pollution levels becoming restricted to eastern England on Friday, with cooler and cloudier weather spreading into western parts, along with showers. Remaining generally Low elsewhere in the UK.

Outlook: Low levels of air pollution are expected through the weekend and into the coming week, as breezier and cooler conditions spread across the UK, along with occasional showers.
