Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
Many central and eastern areas will have a dry, bright start with some sunshine. However, rain will already be affecting parts of Northern Ireland, with showers fringing parts of western Wales and southwest England. During the day the rain, preceded by scattered showers, will spread to many parts, reaching East Anglia and southeast England later in the afternoon. Some heavy, persistent rain is expected. Brighter, slightly drier conditions should reach western districts later. Temperatures near normal, but feeling cooler where the rain persists.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Rain or showers on Wednesday, mainly in the east. Some patchy rain in northern districts on Thursday.
