Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 1800 UTC Wednesday 01 June to 1800 UTC Thursday 02 June 2022

General Situation

The United Kingdom will lie in a slack airflow during the next 24 hours, with early showers over the eastern half of England dying away during Wednesday evening. An Atlantic frontal system will spread outbreaks of rain across some western areas during Thursday and Friday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Northwesterly 3 or 4 at first except in Moray Firth, otherwise variable 3 or less, becoming northeasterly 2 to 4 later.

Slight or moderate near Orkney and Rattray Head, but elsewhere smooth or slight. Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or northeast 2 to 4.

Slight or moderate to the north and west of Orkney, but elsewhere smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4 becoming variable 3 or less, occasionally 4 again later in south.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first near Rattray Head and smooth in south. Showers later in south.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 to 4 becoming northeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 for a time later in south.

Slight in north, smooth or slight in south.

Showers at first in south.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less becoming southwest 2 to 4, backing southeast 3 to 5 later. Slight.

Showers later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 3 to 5 backing east or southeast 2 to 4, then backing northeast later.

Slight.

Showers then fair.

Good.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 2 or 3 becoming variable 3 or less, then southeast 4 or 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 4 or 5 backing east 3 or 4, then northeast 4 or 5 later.

Slight.

Fair.

Good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, occasionally 4 at first, becoming easterly 3 to 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Showers at first, perhaps thundery, becoming fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly 3 to 5, backing northeasterly 4 or 5 later.

Slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Mainly fair.

Good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 3 or 4 becoming variable 2 then easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Showers at first, perhaps thundery, becoming fair.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in east, decreasing 3 at times in west.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 3 or 4 becoming variable 3 or less, then east 3 to 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 3 to 5 becoming variable mainly northeast 2 to 4.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 to 4 becoming east 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 3 or 4 becoming variable mainly northeast 2 to 4.

Slight or moderate.

Showers later.

Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later in west.

Fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or less becoming east or northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.
Slight or moderate in west, smooth or slight in east.
Showers later.
Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel
24 hour forecast:
Variable 3 or less, occasionally 4 later.
Smooth or slight.
Fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or less becoming east or northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later.
Fair then showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway
24 hour forecast:
West or northwest 2 to 4 becoming variable 3 or less, then occasionally 4 again later.
Smooth, occasionally slight.
Fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or less becoming east or northeast 3 to 5.
Smooth or slight.
Fair then rain or showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Isle of Man
24 hour forecast:
Variable 3 or less, becoming south or southeast 2 or 3 later.
Smooth, occasionally slight.
Fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable mainly southeast 2 or 3 becoming east or northeast 3 to 5.
Smooth or slight.
Fair then showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough
24 hour forecast:
Variable 3 or less, becoming south or southeast 3 or 4 for a time later.
Smooth, occasionally slight.
Rain or showers later.
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or less becoming east or northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.
Smooth or slight.
Rain or showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4 for a time later.
Smooth, occasionally slight.
Mainly fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less becoming easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.
Smooth, occasionally slight.
Fair then showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming east or southeast 3 or 4 for a time.
Smooth or slight.
Fair then rain or showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable becoming east or northeast, 2 to 4.
Smooth or slight.
Showers, mainly in south.
Good.

The Minch

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less at first in south, otherwise easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4.
Smooth or slight.
Fair, then rain or showers in south.
Good, occasionally moderate in south.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 3 to 5.
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate in far north.
Showers at first in south.
Good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less at first in south, otherwise easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.
Smooth or slight in south, slight throughout in north.
Fair, then rain or showers in south.
Good, occasionally moderate in south.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 3 to 5.
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate in north.
Showers at first in south.
Good.

Good, perhaps locally moderate at times.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or northeast 2 to 4, occasionally 5 before midnight, backing north for a time in the afternoon.

Smooth or slight with a low swell.

Risk of showers.

Good, perhaps locally moderate.

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
