

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Cloudy and dull in most parts of England and Wales, with mist or fog patches clearing slowly. A few bright or sunny intervals here and there. Much of Northern Ireland starting sunny, though with cloud spreading from the south. Scotland also cloudy, quite windy and mild, though sunshine in the northeast.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
Continuing mostly dry and cloudy over England and Wales with some light drizzle in places, also some brighter intervals. A light east or southeast wind will develop. Northern Ireland and southern Scotland also rather cloudy and mild, but northern Scotland should see more sunshine.
