

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Sunday 03 Oct 2010

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Persistent heavy rain over Wales and western England this morning will spread northeastwards, reaching all parts of the UK during the day before clearing the east coast by late afternoon. Further rain, locally heavy, will move into southeast England, persisting until dawn. Elsewhere it will be dry with patchy cloud with fog forming under clearer skies. Brisk southerly winds easing.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Rain will slowly clear southeast England leaving Monday mainly dry. Rain will then reach the western mainland during the evening, crossing the UK during the night. Further persistent, heavy rain will cross the UK on Tuesday. Temperatures remain near normal.
