Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
Sunny intervals and showers, wintry on hills, in Northern Ireland.  
Northwest Scotland will start bright, then cloud will thicken  
bringing showery rain, with strengthening northerly wind. England,  
Wales and the rest of Scotland cloudy, with outbreaks of rain, heavy  
at times in north and west. Eastern England should stay dry much of  
the morning.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
Apart from eastern England, outbreaks of rain are expected on Sunday,  
chiefly in Scotland and Northern Ireland. The rain will largely die  
out, sunny spells spreading from the east. Tuesday mostly dry at  
first, with some sunshine. Rain and strengthening wind in Scotland,  
Northern Ireland later.
