Headline:

Patchy rain or snow then some fog. Rain to northwest tomorrow.

This Evening and Tonight:

Some southeastern areas can expect rain or snow for a time, while in northern Scotland, patchy rain should largely clear. Otherwise, fog patches are likely with frost in places.

Sunday:

Rain will move eastwards to reach much of Scotland and Northern Ireland, while England and Wales should stay dry with patchy fog lingering in places.

Outlook for Monday:

Generally mild with outbreaks of rain.
