Headline:

Mostly cool/cloudy, showery rain, chiefly N.England/S.Scotland.
Mist/drizzle in east.

This Evening and Tonight:

Outbreaks of rain, chiefly northern England/southern Scotland,
perhaps reaching southwest England later. Mist/coastal fog/drizzle
persisting in east, spreading inland.

Monday:

Dull start. Further outbreaks showery rain, chiefly Scotland,
Northern Ireland and southwest. Staying misty on east coasts,
brighter inland and in west.

Outlook for Tuesday:

Mostly cloudy, dull east. Rain spreading north across England/Wales.
Outbreaks rain northern Scotland largely dying out. Brightest
northwest Scotland.
