

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Sleet and snow in southern Scotland and the far northeast of England will gradually ease south through the afternoon. Early rain in Northern Ireland will give an ice risk, with this perhaps turning to heavy snow later. Elsewhere, it will be mainly dry and sunny after overnight freezing fog clears, although scattered wintry showers will continue in northern Scotland.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Outbreaks of sleet and snow in parts of Wales and central Britain on Tuesday. Otherwise, it will be mainly dry and sunny, with severe overnight frosts and freezing fog patches, but wintry showers will continue along exposed northern and eastern coasts.
