Headline:

Warm sunshine developing in places today. Many places dry overnight.

Today:

Starting rather cloudy, some patchy rain/drizzle. Becoming mainly dry, bright/sunny spells developing, away from western coasts. Cloud increasing across northwestern parts, some rain/drizzle later.

Tonight:

Mostly dry with some clear spells. Rather cloudy in northwest and some western coasts, some rain/drizzle.

Outlook for Saturday:

Cloudy with patchy rain in the northwest. Mainly dry elsewhere with sunny spells developing. Still rather cloudy, west/north coasts.
