Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Patchy rain and sleet across central and southern parts this morning should largely die away as bright or sunny intervals develop. Drier at first in northern areas with bright spells but thicker cloud will spread rain into the far northwest towards evening.  
Tonight, the rain area will spread across northern areas and across western parts with snow over higher ground and on the eastern edge of the rain area. Central and eastern parts will be dry with a sharp frost.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Rain and snow in northern and western parts of Saturday, brighter on Sunday. Frosty nights in the south.
