

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Saturday 17 Oct 2015

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
It'll be chilly at first in the north and west, with fog patches slowly clearing to leave a fine day here. Elsewhere it'll be often cloudy, especially towards the southeast where it will be breezy with some rain too. Western and northwestern parts will again turn chilly under clear skies overnight, with milder and cloudier conditions for most other parts.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Both Sunday and Monday will stay largely dry. The best of the sunshine will generally be in the north and west, with a little rain elsewhere, but this should only be light and the breeze in the southeast will ease.
