Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Most places will be dry with widespread early frost and local mist or fog patches, followed by good spells of sunshine. The fog may be slow to clear in places. Scotland will be more cloudy with outbreaks of rain or drizzle, chiefly in the west, followed by showers in the north. Light winds.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Scotland will be cold, windy with showers, wintry on hills, on Monday, mostly dry and sunny on Tuesday. Elsewhere should be mostly dry, sunny in many places, perhaps more cloudy over the south. There may be showers on eastern coasts during Tuesday.
