

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A bright day for many, after cold and frosty start. Scattered showers continuing across the north and west, some wintry over Scottish hills. Cloud and outbreaks of rain will spread into western parts through the day, along with increasing southwesterly winds. Overnight, outbreaks of rain will spread east, turning heavy at times and falling as snow over the Scottish hills.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Remaining unsettled and rather cold. Rain separated by periods of sunshine and showers in the south. Wintry showers in the north, leading to some snow accumulations on the hills. Winds will remain strong for all, with gales across northern parts.
