

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Scattered heavy, slow-moving showers across England and Wales, these locally torrential with hail and thunder. More prolonged rain will affect parts of Northern England and eastern Scotland. Meanwhile, Northern Ireland and western Scotland should experience fewer showers. Also, becoming quite windy in the south. Overnight, rain and showers will continue across many eastern areas, but drying up in the west.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
A much drier day during Sunday with sunny spells and light winds. A few isolated showers could still develop, mainly across northern and eastern England. Wind and rain will arrive in the west for Monday, this gradually spreading eastwards later.
