

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Mainly dry and mild, but rather cloudy for most, with light drizzle again possible in western areas, whilst eastern parts stay largely dry. Rain in the northwest of the UK will ease and sink southwards during the day, coming to lie from Northern Ireland across to the England-Scotland border by dusk, with brisk winds here also easing.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:
Mainly dry and mild over the weekend, but often rather cloudy, perhaps giving patchy drizzle in exposed western parts. Meanwhile, eastern areas should stay dry throughout, also seeing the best of any sunny spells. Fog patches may form in prolonged cloud breaks overnight.
