Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
The snow will ease today but with the risk of some accumulations to low levels in northern England and the southeast of the Midlands. Rain will continue in the east and showers will move into the west. It'll be windy in the south, with coastal gales. Rain in the east will slowly ease tonight and the winds will become lighter.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Showers will mainly affect central and southern parts tomorrow, with some heavy outbreaks and hail likely. There'll be bright or sunny spells elsewhere though. Friday will be largely dry and bright, before locally heavy rain arrives from the west later.
