


**Yellow warning**

## Heavy rain may cause disruption from flooding.

### What to expect

- Homes and businesses could be flooded, causing damage to some buildings
- Delays or cancellations to train and bus services are possible
- Spray and flooding could lead to difficult driving conditions and some road closures
- Some communities may be cut off by flooded roads
- Possible power cuts and loss of other services to some homes and businesses

### Further details

A band of heavy rain will spread east across Northern Ireland on Saturday morning, becoming slow-moving across eastern areas through the day, before dying out in the evening. 20-30 mm of rain is expected widely across the east, with 40-50 mm possible in some areas, most likely in County Down.

### Reason for update

The warning area has been expanded slightly westwards and the likelihood of impacts increased.
