

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Sunday 16 Sep 2007

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain across Scotland and Northern Ireland will spread southwards although the southeastern half of England should stay dry and sunny until evening. Sunny spells and scattered showers will follow to northern areas. Tonight, rain in the south will become confined to the extreme southeast. More persistent rain in far north of Scotland, mainly dry elsewhere but chilly.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Cool Monday with northerly winds, some bright or sunny spells but also scattered showers, some heavy, with more persistent areas of cloud and rain across some eastern parts of Britain. Most places dry on Tuesday with sunny periods and light winds.
