Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Cloud and outbreaks of rain in the north will gradually push southeastwards, though the rain will tend to die out, to leave a cloudy but largely dry afternoon across southern Britain. Colder conditions follow into northern areas, with blustery showers.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Many parts of the UK fine and dry on Sunday, with variable amounts of cloud and some bright or sunny spells. Feeling pleasant in the sunshine with light winds in the south. However, outbreaks of rain and brisk winds are expected across northwestern Britain. Monday should be largely dry and bright across the UK, with light winds and sunny spells.
