

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Saturday 07 Feb 2009

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Initially widespread ice on untreated roads. Wintry showers will continue across Scotland, Wales, southwest and northeast England, while showers gradually die away across Northern Ireland and the West Midlands. Overnight wintry showers also dying away across remaining western areas, while persisting across northeast Scotland and northeast England. Otherwise dry, sunny today and clear overnight. Cold today, widespread severe frost overnight.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Sunday rain, sleet on high ground, will spread east across the southern areas. Elsewhere sleet, increasingly turning to snow, will extend northeastwards, although northeast Scotland remaining largely dry. Monday snow clearing Scotland, rain and sleet southern England, otherwise wintry showers.
