Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
After a frosty start, many central and northern areas of the UK will see a largely dry day with some sunny spells. Showers, wintry at times will continue to affect northern Scotland. Rain will only slowly ease away from southeast England, and it may stay damp all day to the southeast of London. Generally feeling on the cold side.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Another very cold start on Sunday, with a widespread frost. Then most places will see some sunshine, but with a scattering of showers also. Perhaps more general cloud across the far southeast. Increasingly wet, and at times, windy, on Monday.
