

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Tuesday 10 Jul 2012

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Mainly cloudy, with occasionally heavy showers, while parts of Scotland will see more persistent rain. It will remain rather cool for July, particularly in the more exposed north. Overnight, persistent rain over parts of Scotland should continue, with eastern England also seeing occasionally heavy evening showers. Elsewhere, showers should ease for a time before re-developing later in the night.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

On Wednesday, rain should continue to affect parts of northeastern UK, while occasionally heavy showers develop elsewhere. Many places will become dry but chilly into Thursday, with a fine start for many giving way to further rain from southwestern parts later.
