

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Wednesday 27 Feb 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Scattered showers over northern and western Scotland, wintry over high ground.
Scattered showers over Northern Ireland, northwest Wales and across northwest
England. Most remaining areas dry with some good sunny spells, though rather
cloudy conditions across southern counties of England. Showers continuing over
northwestern Britain overnight with rain spreading across southwest England.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Rain over southwestern England moving east across southern England during
Thursday morning then most of England and Wales dry with light winds and long
sunny spells across the Midlands. Rain spreading southeastwards across Scotland.
On Friday heavy rain spreading east across all parts, accompanied by very strong
winds.
