

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Saturday 04 Oct 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain across Northern Ireland and Scotland, locally heavy, later today clearing away southeastwards. Overnight scattered showers will follow to northern Scotland, heavy across the Northern Isles, while the rest of Scotland and Northern Ireland remain dry. Across England and Wales wet and windy weather will gradually spread east today, then persisting through the night. Gales developing along some southern coasts.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Heavy rain and strong winds slowly clear eastwards from England and Wales tomorrow. Showers across northern Scotland, otherwise Scotland and Northern Ireland dry with sunny spells. Monday rain arriving across western parts of the UK, eastern places dry and bright.
