Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Wintry showers are likely across Northern and Eastern Scotland, and Northern England. Long spells of sunshine are expected elsewhere, but a few wintry showers may develop in some western parts from midday. Wintry showers continuing across northeastern parts of the UK overnight, with a few showers affecting Wales and Southwest England for a time. Mostly dry elsewhere but bitterly cold.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Further wintry showers across Scotland and Northern England over the weekend with a few scattered showers spreading to central and eastern parts of England on Saturday evening. Largely dry and fine elsewhere but very cold with overnight frost and ice.
