

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A much brighter, drier day in the west and north, but scattered showers in Northern Ireland and western Scotland. Cloud and outbreaks of locally heavy rain through parts of central and eastern England, however, with the risk of an isolated heavy shower or thunderstorm in the south-east later. Very warm.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

An increasing risk of thundery rain spreading in across southeast England later on Thursday with this then pushing north up eastern parts of the UK overnight and through Friday. Further showers in north-western parts, whilst elsewhere will see essentially dry conditions with good sunny spells. Very warm in the south-east.
