

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Tuesday 06 Feb 2007

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Snow showers across northern Scotland. Otherwise mainly dry, sunny, after a frosty start with patchy freezing fog slowly dispersing. However, wintry showers will affect some coasts. Often cloudy across Wales and southern England. Southwest England occasional light rain, with the rain turning to snow inland overnight. Elsewhere tonight dry and frosty, except snow showers continuing across northern and eastern coasts.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:
Snow showers across northern then eastern Scotland both days, and eastern England's coast on Wednesday. Elsewhere mainly dry, with sunny spells for Wednesday. Thursday a band of sleet or snow will push northeastwards, leading to significant snow accumulations in places.
