Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
A much drier and brighter but still breezy day as any lingering outbreaks of rain quickly clear east. However scattered showers remain possible, especially into the west. The best of any drier and brighter weather will be in the east. A band of rain and strong winds then spreads in from southwest overnight, with coastal gales.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:
Remaining unsettled and windy throughout with coastal and upland gales in the west and scattered heavy showers. These could turn wintry over the northern hills, whilst southeastern parts are mostly likely to stay dry and bright. Showers and winds will gradually ease on Saturday.
