Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
Although most northern and eastern areas of England will start dry,  
England and Wales can expect rain at times. The rain will be heaviest  
and most persistent in Wales and northwest England, which in some  
areas will add to the already serious flooding situation.  
In northern Scotland, gales will ease and showers move away.  
Otherwise, Scotland and Northern Ireland should be dry and bright in  
places before rain moves from the southwest, although probably not  
reaching the far northeast of Scotland.  
Another mild day is expected, especially towards the south.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:  
Rain gradually clearing southwards as it turns showery and colder.
