Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Outbreaks of rain in western areas at first will spread eastwards through the day, heavy in places, though southeast England may well stay dry until evening. Some snow is likely on hills in Scotland and far northern England for a time. Strong southerly winds, particularly around western coasts and hills, will make it feel cold for many.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Overnight rain will clear eastern Britain on Tuesday morning, then mainly dry and bright for the rest of the day. Further rain will spread across the UK on Tuesday night, leading to an unsettled and windy day on Wednesday. Becoming milder by mid-week.
