Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Rather cloudy on Monday, mostly dry in southern and southwest areas, but most places seeing at least a little rain. There may be a few snow flurries at times in the east. Still rather cold at first in eastern areas, gradually becoming milder from the west.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Fairly cloudy again on Tuesday, but a few bright or sunny intervals developing. Thickening cloud and rain spreading to northwest Scotland later Tuesday. An area of heavier rain will run across Northern Ireland, northern England, Wales and southern Scotland during Wednesday. Temperatures generally near normal.
