

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Showers will continue to affect the eastern coasts of England and Scotland, although tending to ease across Scotland later. Elsewhere largely dry, with plenty of sunny spells. Feeling quite cold however, especially in the east where northerly winds will be quite strong. Showers keeping going across eastern England overnight. Elsewhere, clearing skies, lighter winds and a patchy ground frost.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Cold with further rain or showers for eastern England on Sunday. Elsewhere, dry, albeit increasingly cloudy across central areas. Generally cloudy again on Monday with outbreaks of rain or drizzle, mainly across eastern and central parts. Temperatures rising slightly by Monday.
