Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Most places will be dry and cloudy. Fog in Northern Ireland and southern Scotland will clear slowly. Rain and strengthening winds in far north overnight. Late afternoon sunshine in parts of England and Wales, followed by local frost and fog patches. Feeling less cold than of late.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Sunday, rain and strong winds over far north. Western parts of Scotland and Northern Ireland cloudy, brighter in the east. Fog in England and Wales clearing slowly, then some sunshine. Monday, rain and strong winds spreading slowly south across Scotland. Northern Ireland and northern England mostly cloudy, brighter further south. Winds increasing.
