

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Friday 23 Jul 2010

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Occasional showers in southeast and central southern England, some of them perhaps heavy. Elsewhere, largely dry with sunny spells and just a scattering of light showers. Overnight, showers will die away, but cloud will thicken in western areas, bringing occasional rain or drizzle to western Scotland and Northern Ireland after midnight.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Cloudy in western parts of the UK on both days, with outbreaks of rain and drizzle, and rather misty around western coasts and hills. Drier but still fairly cloudy in central and eastern areas on Saturday, brighter with some sunshine and a few showers in eastern England on Sunday.
